Key grammatical structures to include in the B2 written expression:

• Not only + auxiliary + subject + verb..., but + subject + also...

Example: Not only did she study hard, but she also listened and behaved in class.

• 2nd or 3rd conditional:

Example (2nd): If artificial intelligence supplied human beings, there would be chaos in the world.

Example (3rd): If teenagers had paid attention in class, they wouldn't have failed the exams.

Passive:

Example: Only 9% of plastic has been recycled this year worldwide.


• Reported speech:

Example: When participants were asked about mobile phones, they said that they hadn't used

their mobile phones at all during

the last week.
